

Congregation Safety

The ability to quickly notify first responders of a dangerous security event is critical. Preventing unauthorized access to public facilities is also central to any successful security plan. Having visibility into incidents in real-time and identifying their location to authorities can make all the difference.

The following measures can be implemented quickly
— often using existing infrastructure

1. Video Surveillance

Cameras provide visibility to all areas of the facility day or night



2. Video Access

Video feeds can be viewed from any administrator's phone or tablet



7. Key card Access

Secure entry door controls that restrict the flow of guest access to sensitive areas



6. Intrusion/Fire Monitoring

If a security threat is detected on site, an advanced alarm system sends a signal to our central station



3. Video Intercom

Electronic chime, video monitor/camera, and two-way voice



4. Safe Rooms

An area with a door that can be locked from either side



5. Emergency Buttons

Integrated alert stations that staff can activate in case of emergency
