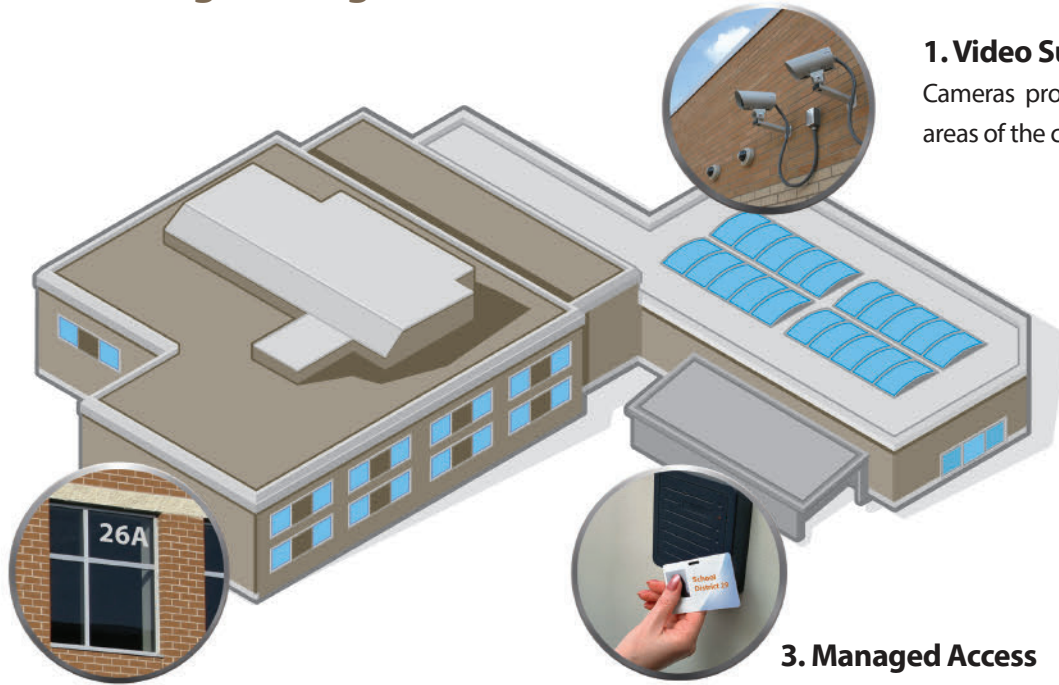


Increase Campus Security

The ability to quickly notify first responders of a dangerous security event is critical. Preventing unauthorized access in public facilities is also central to any successful security plan. Having visibility into incidents in real-time and identifying their location to authorities can make all the difference.

The following measures can be implemented quickly
— often using existing infrastructure



1. Video Surveillance

Cameras provide visibility to all areas of the campus day or night



2. Remote Access

Video feeds can be viewed from any administrator's smart phone or tablet

3. Managed Access

Secure entry door controls that restrict the flow of guest access to sensitive areas

4. Reflective Window Identifiers

Numbers make it easy to identify classrooms from the outside



5. Mass Notification

Audible/inaudible alerts to all occupants on site



6. Double-sided Door locks

Can be locked from either side



7. Panic Buttons

Integrated equipment that staff and/or students can activate in case of emergency
